

VOLUNTEER ACREEMENT

POSITION SUMMARY: Volunteers support Hale Makua Health Services' mission to improve the well-being of those in our care through compassionate personalized health services in our home and yours by:

- 1. Enhancing services currently provided by Hale Makua Health Services.
- 2. Providing individual services to residents as directed by the Volunteer Specialist, or the Supervisor of the Department to which the volunteer is assigned.
- 3. Providing support services to various departments or at events held on the campus or in the community.
- 4. Providing residents with personal companionship from the community.
- 5. Exhibiting compassion for fellow, volunteers, residents, families, and staff.

POSITION RELATIONSHIPS:

- 1. Responsible to: Volunteer Coordinator
- 2. Interrelationships: Works closely with residents, staff, managers and family.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Compassion and willingness to give time and energy.
- 2. Must be able to perform own activities of daily living independently.
- 3. Must be at least 16 years old unless accompanied at all times by an adult.
- 4. Must clear criminal background check.
- 5. Must clear 2 step TB skin test before assignment and annually thereafter.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

AGREEMENT:

As a Hale Makua Health Services Volunteer, I agree to the following:

- 1. Learn and follow the all Volunteer Policies and Procedures.
- 2. Wear my name badge at all times.
- 3. Comply with Hale Makua Health Services' requirement of an annual Tuberculosis (TB) screening.
- 4. To call in advance of my normal start time if I am unable to come in or if I plan to stop volunteering.
- 5. Have instructions for handling wheel chairs.
- 6. Not to provide clinical care including feeding, transferring, or toileting residents.
- 7. To report immediately any resident fall and seek staff assistance. I will not attempt to lift an injured resident.
- 8. To report any emergency including a fire, a resident fall, or any other event which could cause harm to a resident or staff member or loss to Hale Makua Health Services.

- Administrative support such as filing, copying and light computer work.
- Talk story with residents
- Transport residents to and from daily activities and events
- Read to residents
- Play table games
- Assist on excursions
- Craft preparation and assembly
- Nature walks with residents outdoors on wheel chair paths
- Assist with letter writing upon request
- Visit residents on a one to one basis in Day Health or in the neighborhoods.
- Provide manicures for residents
- Assist at large functions such as May Day programs, County Fair, Aloha Week programs
- Provide entertainment for the residents
- Transport residents to and from exercise departments and neighborhoods
- Assist therapists as needed with non-clinical tasks
- Set resident up for therapeutic exercise under the supervision of the therapist
- Assist during meals with handing out resident food trays and encouraging residents to eat
- Assist our Environmental Services and Maintenance Departments with making our campus a beautiful and safe place to live.
- Work with Nutrition Services staff to make and deliver meals and/or wash dishes.
