



Visitation Policy

- **Residents who are fully vaccinated (>2 weeks since completion of vaccine series) can choose to be in close proximity and/or touch contact with a visitor.**
- **Residents who aren't fully vaccinated (>2 weeks since completion of vaccine series) will stay a minimum of 6 feet apart.**

Visits and food drop-offs will be organized according to the residents' respective neighborhoods. For Kahului, feel free to call your neighborhoods with any questions. For Wailuku, contact Activities Director Jordan Kahiamoe at 808-243-1712.

Vaccinated Residents

- Visits for vaccinated residents will be done inside the facility. Kahului visiting hours will be from *3:00 pm – 5:00 pm, M-F*. Each visit will be *1 hour long*. Please be on time. If you are late your visit will be cut short. (For Wailuku, please contact the Activities Director at (808) 243-1712 for available visitation times).
- You will be allowed 3 visitors at a time. Children from birth on up are allowed. Children older than 2 must mask. Children must be always supervised.
- Visitors are not allowed on resident neighborhoods or in resident rooms unless you have prior approval for compassionate visits.
- You may utilize this visiting time to bring your loved ones approved food.
- You will be screened and required to wear a mask.

Non-vaccinated Residents

Curbside visits will continue with the following parameters:

- Each visit will be *15 mins*. Please be on time. If you are late your visit will be cut short.
- Kahului visitation times are from *9:30 am – 10:30 am*.
- For Wailuku, please contact the Activities Director at (808) 243-1712 for available visitation times.
- You are allowed 3 visitors. Please try to come in one car due to limited parking.
- Children from birth on up are allowed. Children older than 2 must mask. Children must always be supervised and are not allowed to move in, around and/or outside of their visiting area.
- You may utilize this visiting time to bring your loved ones approved food.
- You will be screened and required to wear a mask.
